

McGuireWoods Lawyers Inducted Into N.C. Pro Bono Honor Society

The North Carolina Pro Bono Resource Center inducted 37 McGuireWoods lawyers into its 2018 North Carolina Pro Bono Honor Society. According to the PBRC, these lawyers each provided 50 or more hours of pro bono legal services in 2018, thus meeting the aspirational threshold set by the North Carolina Rules of Professional Conduct.

The [full list](#) of 2018 inductees included 468 lawyers who, as a group, provided more than 41,000 hours of pro bono legal services to North Carolinians living in poverty. Each member receives a certificate of recognition from the Supreme Court of North Carolina.

“The North Carolina Pro Bono Honor Society helps us as a legal profession to shine a light on those attorneys making outstanding contributions to North Carolinians who need, but cannot afford, legal help,” said North Carolina Supreme Court Chief Justice Cheri Beasley in a press release announcing the inductees. “By recognizing these important and valuable pro bono services, we celebrate our state’s lawyers committed to ensuring equal access to justice for all.”
